- Current status/progress on an ongoing research project
- Wider applications of current or novel tools, techniques, and methodologies
- A new research concept, and possible benefits/applications
- A broad review of an important research topic and possible future directions

Please limit the length of the presentation to 5 minutes and the abstract to 150 words. Any digital device can be used to record the presentations (e.g., smartphone, laptop, tablet, etc.)
